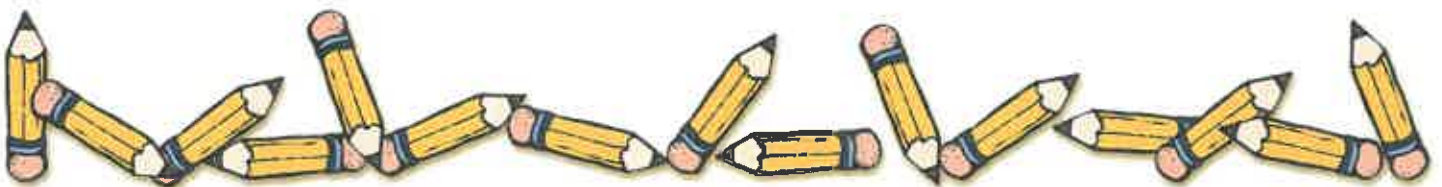

➤ There are a few items that you will need to bring on the first day of school:

- Please remember to **label everything** with a permanent marker (all supplies, coats, boots, gloves etc. – even pencils)
- We will put your child's extra supplies in a cupboard so they are available when needed.
- Third graders go through supplies quickly so it is good to check once a month throughout the school year to see what your child needs. School supplies tend to be cheaper during back-to-school sales. You may want to buy extras during these sales and put them aside for later in the year.

➤ Please note that large notebooks and Trapper Keepers will not fit in the student's desks so they will not need these.

We are looking forward to meeting all of you. During the summer, you will want to have your child practice their addition and subtraction facts to 20 – the better they know these, the more quickly we will be able to move along in the fall. And always, the more reading they do over the summer the better.

SUPPLY LIST – GRADE 4

1 clipboard

1 spiral notebook - 70 page, wide-ruled

1 zippered pouch or small pencil box

2 large boxes of tissues

1 pair child-safe scissors (Fiskars are best)

2 dozen #2 pencils - not mechanical- Ticonderoga brand is preferred – no label required

1 pkg. cap erasers

1 small box crayons

1 small set colored pencils

5 heavy weight pocket folders

2 glue sticks

2 yellow highlighters

1 package of 4 black whiteboard markers

2 big tubs of Clorox disinfecting wipes

1 backpack or book bag - no wheels

1 lunch bag or lunch money

Fifth Grade Supply List 2018**

Please bring the following supplies on the first day of school, and make sure all items are labeled with your name!

- 4 dozen #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) You will likely need more mid-year; please label pencils with your name.
- 2 large, pink erasers
- colored pencils (optional)
- large pencil pouch or box
- 2 fine point, black permanent markers
- 2 packages/sets of fine point, low odor dry erase markers
- 1 composition book (the marble-looking cover with pages sewn in)
- 1 large backpack (no rolling backpacks; these do not fit in the lockers)
- 4 large boxes of tissues (more will likely be needed mid-year)
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes (e.g. Clorox Wipes)

- **Snacks (non-perishable items) (Nut Free/Peanut Free only, please)**

We have a snack time each day. We do ask the children to bring a "healthy snack" with them each day, but sometimes a child will not have one. We like to have snacks on hand for anyone who might need one. Ideas:
crackers, pretzels, popcorn, mini bags of chips, fruit snacks, graham crackers, etc.

Parents/Guardians: If you are willing to buy an extra item or 2 for students who do not bring supplies, this would be greatly appreciated. We have mini-white boards for the students to use, and we run out of the fine-tip dry erase markers quickly! If you are willing to donate extras of any of the above items, we would greatly appreciate it. Thanks!
