PBIS Lessons: Grades K & 1

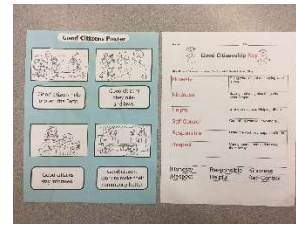

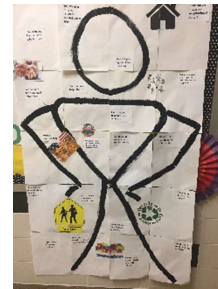
