

# Pre-K Supply List 2019-2020

1. Rubber soled shoes to be used daily (Velcro sneakers work best)
2. A change of clothes (underwear, pants/shorts, shirt, & socks) to leave in school
3. Backpack(full size) - needs to hold the daily folder, shoes, snow pants (in winter), science projects and art treasures
4. If you will be sending lunch with your child, you will need to include a drink. Non-breakable items please!
5. We do go outside all winter and in all weather. Please send rain gear if it looks like rain. Your child will need snow pants, gloves and boots for the winter.
6. Supplies –
  - Four containers of disinfectant wipes
  - One box of tissues
  - **\*\*If your child is not potty trained you will need to provide disposable diapers/pull-ups and wipes for daily use for your child**

**Please label coats, snow pants, sweaters, clothing, backpacks, and lunch boxes with your child's name.**

1- standard, plastic, pencil box, not a pouch or bag please.

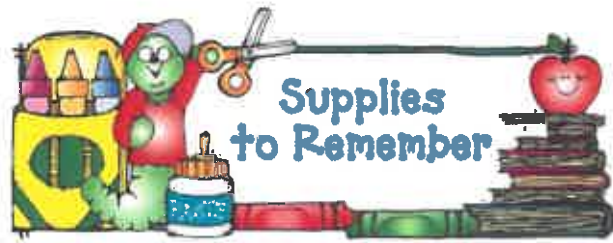
1- large durable backpack- needs to be sent daily. No "wheeled" models. Backpacks should be able to fit folders, snow pants, sneakers, etc.

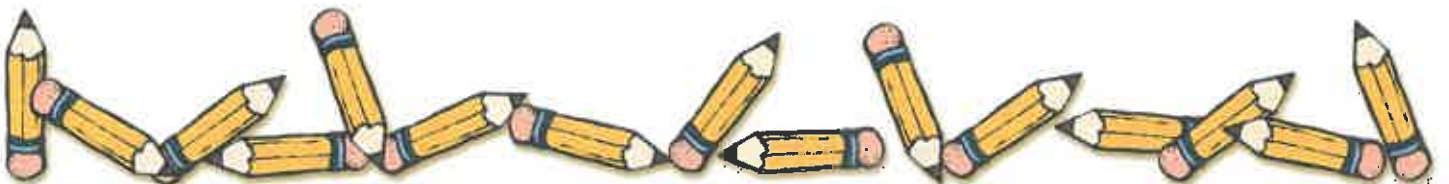

➤ There are a few items that you will need to bring on the first day of school:

- **Please remember to label everything with a permanent marker (all supplies, coats, boots, gloves etc. – even pencils)**
  - **We will put your child's extra supplies in a cupboard so they are available when needed.**
  - **Third graders go through supplies quickly so it is good to check once a month throughout the school year to see what your child needs. School supplies tend to be cheaper during back-to-school sales. You may want to buy extras during these sales and put them aside for later in the year.**
- Please note that large notebooks and Trapper Keepers will not fit in the student's desks so they will not need these.

We are looking forward to meeting all of you. During the summer, you will want to have your child practice their addition and subtraction facts to 20 – the better they know these, the more quickly we will be able to move along in the fall. And always, the more reading they do over the summer the better.

**Please bring the following supplies on the first day of school, and make sure all items are labeled with your name!**

- 4 dozen #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) You will likely need more mid-year; please label pencils with your name.
- 2 large, pink erasers
- 2 rolls of transparent tape (e.g. Scotch)
- colored pencils (optional)
- large pencil pouch or box
- 1 fine point, black permanent markers
- 2 packages/sets of fine point, low odor dry erase markers
- 1 composition book (the marble-looking cover with pages sewn in)
- 1 large backpack (no rolling backpacks; these do not fit in the lockers)
- 3 large boxes of tissues (more will likely be needed mid-year)
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes (e.g. Clorox Wipes)
