**PBIS Topic of the Month:**


**SUMMER SAFETY**

**Review Tips for Summer**




During all in-class PBIS Lessons for summer safety, we reviewed basic safety tips for riding a bike, summing, walking, applying sunscreen, and bug spray.

**PBIS Lessons: Grades K & 1**

During the K & 1<sup>st</sup> grade PBIS lessons, we also spoke about stranger danger, tricky people, and who to ask, for help, if ever lost.

**PBIS Lessons: Grades 2 & 3**



During the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grade PBIS lessons, we reviewed summer safety, spoke about stranger danger, tricky people, and personal body safety.

**PBIS Lessons: Grades 4 & 5**



During the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade PBIS lessons, we spoke about the difference between strangers and tricky people. We discussed warning signs, safety plans, and how to keep safe from child predators.
